CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Student Instructors - Actual course teachers, prepare lesson materials, subject to student reviews - NOT graders, tutors or assistants

MASTER'S or PhD STUDENTS - must have completed all undergrad requirements

Graduate Assistant - Teaching Assistants Actual course teachers, prepare lesson materials, subject to student reviews - NOT graders, tutors or assistants

Graduate Assistant - Research Assistants Pursuing ORIGINAL research, directly supervised by faculty

EXCEPTIONS

1. Exceptions to pay rates **BELOW** values listed on this scale must be approved by the Manager of Student Employment.
2. Exceptions to pay rates **ABOVE** values listed on this scale must be approved by your Dean, the Academic Vice President's Office and the Manager of Student Employment.
3. Exceptions to pay rates **ABOVE** values listed on this scale, which are **paid on Research Accounts**, will be reviewed by Regulatory Accounting.
