Graduate Assistant - Teaching Assistants Actual course teachers, prepare lesson materials, subject to student reviews - NOT graders, tutors or assistants Graduate Assistant - Research Assistants Pursuing ORIGINAL research, directly supervised by faculty

EXCEPTIONS
